

WASTE MANAGEMENT PICK-UP DAYS

Waste Management will observe the following holidays: **NEW YEARS DAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY.**

When these holidays fall during a normal work week, collection is delayed one day for the remainder of the week. For example, if a holiday falls on Tuesday, Monday collection is picked up as scheduled on Monday, the normal Tuesday collection will be delayed until Wednesday, Wednesday's until Thursday, etc...,for the remainder of the week. Normal scheduling resumes the following week.

Here is how the new sections break down, please read the full line carefully to determine your collection day:

MONDAY

West of I-275 AND South of S. Huron Road (but not S. Huron Road)

TUESDAY

North Side of S. Huron Road (including S. Huron) AND West of Vining (but not Vining Road)

WEDNESDAY

East of Vining Road (including Vining) AND NORTH of West Road (including West Road) Your day will remain the same.

THURSDAY

South of West Road (but not West Road) AND East of I-275

- Please dump your oil in the **IGLOOS** and reuse the container or throw into the **DUMPSTER**.
(PLEASE no oil/gas mix)

Auto Batteries

- Please place your batteries on the wood pallet.

Antifreeze

- Please dump your Anti-Freeze into the **TANK**. Then reuse the container or throw the container into the dumpster.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

If your pick-up day falls on a holiday or the day following the holiday your collection day will be a day late. The following days will be affected: New Years, Memorial, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

**ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED FOR
CURBSIDE PICK-UP**

- Tree Stumps
- Concrete/Bricks
- Construction Materials
- Old Flooring/Wood/Tile
- Lawn Mowers/Engines
- Fencing/Rail Road Ties
- Tires
- Hazardous Waste/Gas/Oil
- Wet Paint Cans (open lid, dry paint to a solid form, then set out for collection with the lids off.
- Car or Truck Parts

Landfill Voucher

If you have some construction debris to dispose of, Waste Management will take up to 1-pick-up truck load at no charge at Woodland Meadows Landfill for Huron Residents. Huron Township Recycles!

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Plastic Bottles with a 1 (PET) or 2 (HDPE) on the Bottom

- Recycle only PLASTIC BOTTLES
1 (PET) or 2 (HDPE) ONLY
- No motor oil or antifreeze bottles,
even with a 1 or 2. BOTTLES ONLY
- **Rinse, discard caps and flatten**

Clear, Green, & Brown Glass Bottles and Jars

- Only bottles & jars, no window glass, no ceramics, no dishes, no drinking glasses, and no light bulbs
- **Rinse & discard caps**

Tin & Aluminum Cans

- **Rinse and discard lids**

Place the above containers loose in recycling bin, not in bags please!

Newspaper (no plastic bags)

- Recycle newspaper and everything that comes with the newspaper
- Place in brown paper bag or loose in recycle bin tucked to one side

Magazines & Telephone Books

- Recycle several magazines at once
- Must be **BUNDLED WITH STRING OR STRONG RUBBERBAND**
- Place to one side of bin

Corrugated Cardboard

- Bundle and tie in 2 foot by 2 foot bundles by 1 foot. Larger pieces cannot fit in the recycle vehicle
- No pizza boxes or cereal type boxes
- Place next to or on top of bin

Household Batteries

- AA, AAA, C, D, 9 and 6 volt batteries only. Place in sealed clear plastic baggie and place in recycle bin.

Waste Management has a commingled recycling system. All items are mixed in the recycle vehicle and sorted at the Recycle Center using magnets, screens and air sorters. For TOURS of the Recycle Center call 248-208-2260.

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

YARD WASTE COLLECTION RUNS

APRIL 1st thru last week of November

Yard Waste Is:

- Grass clippings, leaves, weeds and brush under 2 inches in diameter only.

Place in separate containers free of any rubbish, dirt, sod or recyclables.

The following containers may be used for yard waste collection:

1. Use a 20 to 32-gallon hard plastic container with no plastic bag liner.
 - **Containers larger than 32 gallons will NOT be collected.**
 - Container must have a "Yard Waste" sticker attached (**Stickers available at Township Hall.**)
 - **CONTAINER MUST NOT WEIGH MORE THAN 50 POUNDS.**
2. Use 30-gallon **paper** compost bags available at local stores. **No Plastic!**
3. Branches and small tree limbs must be **TIED** in bundles not exceeding three (3) feet in length and forty (40) pounds in weight. Place next to yard waste.

RECYCLE YOUR YARD WASTE AT HOME:

Use grass clippings as a mulch around plants and shrubs. Mulch adds nitrogen to soil, eliminates weeds and reduces water evaporation.

Place all yard waste at the curb at least ten (10) feet from rubbish & face sticker towards street so the driver can see it.

Place yard waste at the curb no later than 6:00 AM on your regular trash day. If placing rubbish out the night BEFORE, you must wait until after 6:00 PM. All empty cans must be removed from the curb on collection day, after your collection. THANK YOU!

Pick Up Schedule

Your pick-ups will generally fall around the same time each week. However, due to traffic, road conditions and volumes we may sometimes run at a different time. To insure pick up, please set rubbish to the curb the night before or by 6:00 a.m. of your pick-up day. **DO NOT SET TRASH OUT 2-3 DAYS BEFORE YOUR PICK-UP DAY !!!!**



Place rubbish in cans no larger than 32-gallon, with lids or tied plastic bags weighing no more than 50 pounds each. NO

LOOSE ITEMS, items must be in bags, cans or bundled properly for collection.

What About Large Items?

Large items such as furniture, appliances, mattresses, carpet, etc. will be collected on the same day as your rubbish. Place at the curb with your rubbish by 6:00 a.m. or the night before.


NO TELEPHONE CALL IS NEEDED FOR LARGE ITEM COLLECTION. SIMPLY PLACE AT THE CURB ON YOUR REGULAR COLLECTION DAY.

Please remove any doors from items before placing at the curb (for the safety of children playing near by). Bundle all carpet in lengths of 4 feet or less and weighing no more than 50 pounds.



Items With Freon

Refrigeration and air conditioning units contain Freon. It is required by law to have the Freon removed by a "Certified Technician". Look in your local directory under "Refrigerator Repair" for a certified technician. **No**



refrigerator unit will be picked up unless it has the Freon removal certification sticker on it.

Items That We DO NOT TAKE

- Gasoline and Automotive Oil
- Car and Truck Parts/Engines
- Hazardous Wastes
- Construction/Roofing Debris
- Yard Waste Mixed with Trash
- Wood/Dry Wall
- Concrete/Bricks
- Fencing/Railroad Ties
- Tree Stumps
- Wet Paint Cans
 - Let paint dry and place at curb with lid off.

YOUR RUBBISH MAY NOT BE COLLECTED IF:

- Not properly bundled
- Over 50 pound
- Not at curb by 6:00 am
- Has no freon removal sticker
- Larger than 32-gallons cans
- Yard waste mixed with rubbish
- Items not accepted in program
