# NEW RECYCLING PROGRAM EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012

### ***PLEASE READ! IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CHANGES TO HURON TOWNSHIP RECYCLING SERVICES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012!***

Effective January 1, 2012, the Huron Township curbside recycling program will be provided on an every-other-week basis. This guide contains important information related to the every-other-week recycling schedule and program. Please take time to review it in detail and keep it in a convenient location for future reference.

Also, the 64-gallon wheeled cart delivered to your residence will replace your recycle bin. All recyclables can be comingled in the cart. See the guide to the right. Place the cart at the curb with the opening facing the road on your service day.

Please note — this applies to recycling only.

 <p><b>Cardboard &amp; Paper Bags</b> Flatten cardboard &amp; cut into pieces</p>	 <p><b>Junk Mail</b> Envelopes, flyers, brochures, postcards etc.</p>
 <p><b>Paperboard</b> No wax coated paperboard</p>	 <p><b>Newspaper</b> Remove bags, strings and rubber bands</p>
 <p><b>Magazines &amp; Catalogs</b> All types and sizes</p>	 <p><b>Office Paper</b> All types and sizes</p>
 <p><b>Phone Books</b> All types and sizes</p>	<p><b>GLASS</b></p>  <p><b>*Clear Glass</b> Empty Clear Glass Only</p>

METAL
 <p><b>*Steel &amp; Tin Cans</b> Empty cans only</p>
 <p><b>*Aluminum Cans</b> Empty cans only</p>
 <p><b>Kitchen Cookware</b> Metal pots, pans, tins &amp; utensils</p>

PLASTIC
 <p><b>*Plastic Jugs/Bottles</b> (#1 &amp; #2)</p>
 <p><b>*Household Plastic</b> (#3 - #7) Empty containers only</p>
 <p><b>*Plastic Bags</b> Most retail and grocery bags</p>
