On September 20th during our Mini Huron Township Senior Olympics, Huron Township Supervisor, David Glaab, shared with us information regarding the decommission of 3G Service lines via the State 911 Committee. As a recap, all older cell phones that are 3G are being discontinued which includes most flip phones and older-style smartphones. These phones will no longer be able to make calls, including 911 calls, once the networks are taken down. Phasing out of 3G will also impact older home security systems ("Ring" should be ok), tablets, smart watches, and some medical devices. The following are the decommission dates: T-MOBILE (formerly SPRINT) 3G – Jan. 1, 2022 and LTE – June 30, 2022; AT&T – Feb. 2022; and VERIZON – Dec. 31, 2022.
